Note that the records located about the Alleger family have several different spellings including Allegar, Allega, Alliger, etc. In former times, they did not use standardized spellings of names as we do today. Also, sometimes records will have variant spellings because the person said their name in a particular way, and another person wrote down the information based on what he or she heard and made a guess on how it was spelled. The records in Kentucky and Missouri sometimes used the spelling Allega, indicating the family may have pronounced the name without the ending “r” sound, perhaps reflecting a southern U.S. accent.

As stated on his birth certificate below, Robert Lloyd Alleger was born on 23 June 1900 in Gallatin County, Montana. The town was listed as "Rural", indicating that it was outside of an established town in the area. His parents were married. His father was listed as William Robert Alleger, 38 years old, born in Macon County, Missouri, whose occupation was a farmer. His mother was listed as Katie Viola Calhoon, 32 years old, born in Lynne County, Missouri, who was a housewife. It says that his mother Katie had 5 other children born before he was, 3 of whom were living, and 2 of whom were deceased. This was a delayed birth certificate created in 1941 and Robert's sister, Emma, gave the information.

In the 1910 census, Robert Lloyd was listed in the census with his parents living in Gallatin County, Montana. They aren't living in a specific town, but on the side of the page, it says the family was living in South Bozeman. It lists him as Lloyd, age 9, born in Montana with parents born in Missouri, and he was currently attending school.

His father William Alleger is listed as age 47, born in Missouri, with father born in Missouri and mother born in Kentucky. He has been married to his wife for 25 years. He is listed as a general farmer. He owns his home which is a farm and it has a mortgage.

His mother Katie Alleger is listed as age 41, born in Missouri with parents born in Missouri. She has had 6 children, 4 of whom are living.

Also listed as his sister Emma who is 21; his brother Leonard who is 19, and his sister Vernie who is 15.

On 12 September 1918, Robert Lloyd registered for the World War I draft, which was required of all men of eligible age at that time. He stated that he was living in Bozeman, Gallatin County, Montana. He said he was 18 years old and born on 23 June 1900. He was listed as white and native born in the United States. His occupation was a farmer. His employer was his father W. R. Alleges of Bozeman, Montana. He signed his name at the bottom of the card.

Also listed in the family are his father William R and his sister Emma, along with the children of Edward and Verna Cass.

In 1922 and 1923, Robert Lloyd was the administrator for his father’s estate, and his father’s farm and assets were all sold in order to pay his father’s outstanding debts (more information on this is found in the documents about his father).

Sometime between 1923 and 1927, Robert Lloyd moved to the state of Washington. It’s likely he moved because he was looking for work and new opportunities.

In 26 March 1927, Robert L. Alleger is listed in the King County, Washington, marriage license index as obtaining a marriage license along with Janet Northy.

In the 1930 census, Robert L. Alleger was listed as living at 200 King Street in Centralia City, Lewis County, Washington. He was renting his home which is worth \$2,500. The home had a radio set. Robert was 29 years old at his last birthday, and he was first married at age 26. He could read and write and was not currently attending school. He was born in Montana and his parents were born in Missouri. He was working at as a repairman for a telephone company. He worked the day before, and he was not a veteran.

His wife Janet was age 26 at her last birthday. She was 24 years old at the time of her first marriage. She was born in Montana, her mother was born in Sweden and her father was born in Pennsylvania. She did not have an occupation.

Their son Robert L was 2 4/12 years old, born in Washington, with parents born in Montana. He was not attending school.

In the 1940 census, R.L. Alleger is listed as living at 405 Iron Street in Centralia, City, Lewis County, Washington. He was renting his home for \$25 per month. He was age 39 and was born in Montana. He had completed 2 years of high school. He was living in the same house in 1935. In the week of March 24-30, 1940, he worked for 40 hours. He worked as a central office repairman for a telephone company. He worked for 52 weeks in 1939 and earned \$2,800.

His wife Janet who gave the information for this census was 35 years old. She completed 4 years of high school. She was born in Montana and was living in the same house in 1935. She was engaged in home housework.

Robert Lloyd son was age 11 and had completed grade 5, born in Washington. Son Carl Byron was age 9 and had completed grade 3, born in Washington.

On 16 February 1942, Robert registered for the World War II draft, as was required by all eligible men. He said that he was living at 402 North Rock Street in Centralia, Lewis County, Washington. He was 41 years old, born 23 June 1900 in Bozeman, Montana. His wife was Janet M Alleger, living at the same address. He was working for Pacific Tel. & Tel. Co. in Centralia, Lewis, Washington, which was located at 109 N. Pine Street in Centralia. He signed the bottom of the form.

a Bell System subsidiary in Seattle as an installer in 1926, "Central" was serving telephone customers when he came to Centralia in 1929 as a repairman.

"There were three of us in the plant office in those days and we knew practically every one who had a telephone in Centralia. "The blackouts during World War II weren't much fun. I had the night shift and had to drive between Centralia and Chehalis every night without lights. I got so I could drive that road almost with my eyes closed."

Alleger moved to the new dial building as a repairman in 1947. He has been an equipment man since 1960.

**Alleger** is a Mason and has held the office of past master and is now high priest of the Royal Arch Masons. He is also a member and past treasurer of the First Methodist church. He and his wife, Janet, have two grown sons, **Robert** and Carl, and five grandchildren.

Robert Alleger died on 15 April 1994, and his wife Janet died on 16 June 1980. They were buried in the Mountain View Cemetery in Centralia, Washington.

In about 1889, the Alleger family moved to Gallatin County, Montana.

The family is listed in the 1900 census in Salesville Precinct, Gallatin County. Wm Aliger was listed as white, male, born in Oct 1862, 37 years old, had been married for 15 years. He was born in Missouri with both parents born in Missouri. He was unemployed for 0 months. His farm was owned without a mortgage.

Kate was listed as white, female, born in February 1868, 32 years old, married for 15 years. She was the mother of 5 children, 3 of whom were living. She was born in Missouri with both parents born in Missouri.

Children Emma, Leonard, and Verna are also listed.

The census indicates that there were 2 children born to William and Kate Alleger who died before adulthood. One of these was Mary Frances Alleger who was born in 1885 in Missouri and died in 1898 in Gallatin County. She was buried in the Gallatin Gateway Cemetery with her parents.

I was not able to determine who the other child was that died, this child was likely born between Verna that was born in 1894 and Robert Lloyd who was born in 1900. The birth and death records that were kept in Montana at this time were incomplete, and I didn't find a birth record or death record for this child. I also did not find a cemetery tombstone in Gallatin County for this child, nor a mention in the newspaper.

In the 1910 census, William Alleger is listed with his family in Gallatin County. They weren't living in a specific town, but on the side of the page, it says the family was living in South Bozeman. William was age 47, born in Missouri, with father born in Missouri and mother born in Kentucky. He had been married to his wife for 25 years. He was listed as a general farmer. He owned his home which was a farm and it had a mortgage.

His wife Katie Alleger was listed as age 41, born in Missouri with parents born in Missouri. She had had 6 children, 4 of whom are living.

Also listed as their children were Emma, Leonard, Vernie, and Lloyd.

In August 1912, W.R. Alleger experienced a loss of three-fourths of his crop of 76 acres of wheat due to a hailstorm as recorded in the local newspaper (*Bozeman Daily Chronicle*, Fri, Aug 9, 1912, Page 4)

A serious loss from hail in last aSt-urday's storm, not known in Bozeman until yesterday, was suffered by W. R. Alleger, who lives west of Shedd's bridge about five miles. A field of wheat of 76 acres, Mr. Alleger says, will not yield more than one-fourth of a crop. Singularly enough, none of Mr. Alleger's neighbors suffered any loss.





William R Alleger died on 21 Feb 1922. There was an obituary printed in the *Bozeman Daily Chronicle* on Wed, Feb 22, 1922, page 3.

## WILLIAM R. ALLEGER DIES TUESDAY MORNING

William R. Alleger died at 7 o'clock Tuesday morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. E. F. Cass, 716 West Babcock street. He had not been well for about two years and had been confined to bed since Thanksgiving time. He was born in Macon county, Mo., October 24, 1862, and was married when he was 22 years old. He came to Bozeman in the spring of 1889 and has made his home in Gallatin county, most of the time on a farm 15 miles west of Bozeman, ever since. Mrs. Alleger died about eight years ago.

Four children and five grandchildren survive the parents. The children are: Emma Alleger, who has been with her father at the ranch; O. L. Alleger of Butte; Mrs. E. F. Cass of West Babcock street, Bozeman, and Lloyd Alleger, who has also been at the ranch with his father. The grandchildren are Raymond, Ruth and Evelyn Cass; Katherine and Elizabeth Alleger.

Funeral services will be held Thurs-

day morning at 11 o'clock at the Harland and Caven funeral chapel, and interment will be in the Salesville cemetery, by the graves of the wife and a daughter of the deceased. Mr. Alleger was a member of the local lodge of Yeomen, and it is probable that they will take some part in the funeral services.

William Alleger is listed in the 1850 census with his parent in District 50, Linn County, Missouri. The surname was listed as Alaga. William was listed as age 13, male, born in Indiana.

His father Robert Alaga was 40 years old, a farmer who owned \$400 worth of real estate, born in Kentucky.

His mother Nancy was 37 years old, female, born in Kentucky.

Also listed are his brother Giles age 16 and sister Elizabeth age 14.

William Alleger is listed in the 1860 census in Township 58, Range 19, Linn County, Missouri. He was listed as Wm Allega, age 22, male, farm laborer, born in Indiana. He did not own real estate and had personal property worth \$430.

His wife Rachel was age 17, female, born in Kentucky.

His daughter Elizabeth was 3/12 year old, female, born in Missouri.

There were not death records kept by the government in Missouri until later years, so there is no death record of William Alleger. However, it's clear that he died between 1862 when his last child was born and 1870 when his widow Rachel married John T Goddard.

The Linn County probate records list William as an heir to his father Robert's estate when it was probated in 1870. His father Robert Allega/Alleger has died without a will and his wife Nancy was the administratrix of his estate. Robert's children were listed as Giles Alleger, Mary Gardner, and William Alleger. It says that William was deceased and had 3 minor children.

They were listed as Margaret Alleger (listed as Elizabeth Margaret in other records), Mary F Alleger, and James W Alleger, minors, and heirs of their grandfather Robert Alleger. John T Goddard, their stepfather and second husband of their mother Rachel, is listed as their guardian.

Robert Alleger was born in Kentucky in about 1810. There were no birth records kept by the government in Kentucky at that time so there is no birth record for him. He is listed in online trees as the son of Giles Alleger of Garrard County, Kentucky, but I haven't yet located documents to prove his parentage.

Robert Alleger married Nancy Phillips in Orange County, Indiana, on 30 October 1833. They were married by B. Lauthern, the Justice of the Peace of Orange County.

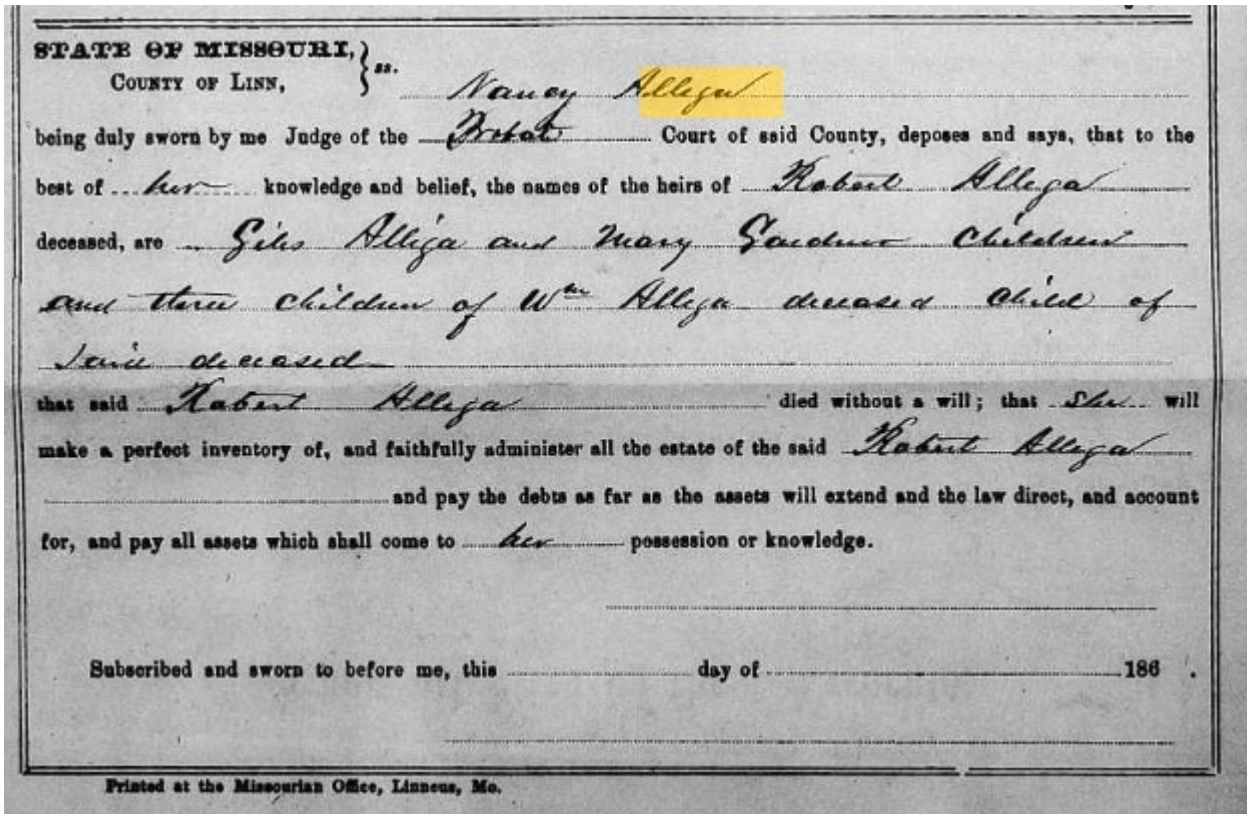

Robert Alleger died without a will so his estate was probated in the Linn County probate court in 1870. His wife Nancy was the administratrix of his estate. Robert's living children were listed as Giles Alleger, Mary Gardner, and William Alleger. William was deceased and had 3 minor children.



Robert's wife Nancy lived with her daughter Mary in her later years. She was listed in the 1900 census in Bucklin Township, Linn County, Missouri. She was listed as age 87, widow, born in Indiana, parents born in Kentucky.

The 1900 census stated that Nancy had 6 children, one of whom was living at that time. Nancy's known children are Giles, Elizabeth, Mary, and William.

The 1840 census indicates there was another young son living in the household of Robert Alleger at that time, but that son is not in the 1850 census with his parents, so he likely died young. The 1840 census lists one female under the age of 5. This could be Elizabeth or could be another daughter. It's unclear who Nancy's other child was, this child likely died young since he or she was not living by 1870 according to the probate records. The census could also be in error and she had only 5 children.
